

First Floor

1. Event Space

 Available for high-profile UNCW sponsored events and functions, especially those that have university-wide appeal and are open to the community

2. Library Research Gallery

 Dynamic exhibit space for digital and traditional exhibitions curated by the library and through partnerships

3. Visualization and Analysis Lab

Immersive 30-foot-long video touch-enabled display wall available for classes, events,
 presentations, and collaboration related to working with and visualizing data and/or graphics-rich content

4. The MakerStudio

- The Makerstudio features several distinct spaces:
 - Expanded makerspace with 3D printing, laser cutting, embroidery, and other fabrication (DH1065)
 - Multipurpose podcasting and media studio (DH 1063)
 - o **Production studio** for creating audio and video content (DH1061)
 - Featuring soundproofing, green screen wall, and studio lighting

5. Library Technology Desk

- Personal assistance with library hardware, software, printers, and more from tech-savvy employees
- Support for many of the technology-enhanced spaces located on the first floor of the Discovery Hall

6. Digitization Lab

 Where the Library's Digital Initiatives unit does high-quality digitization of a variety of materials, such as scrapbooks capturing local history, local government documents, and regional newspapers, using high-capacity specialized scanner

7. Group Study Coves

• Includes 9 spaces with collaboration technology that are available on a first-come, first-served basis

8. Link



9. CSENCAH

- The Center contains original archival collections, rare and locally significant publications, and other
 historical documentary materials related to the Southeast NC region, including the library's Special
 Collections, government documents, and UNCW's University Archives
- While the Center's collections are open for use, because these materials are so unique and historically valuable, they are kept in secure closed stacks that are accessible only to staff. Anyone who wants to access the Center's collections can visit the reading room during their open hours
- The Center is used by hundreds of researchers across the country each year and open to the public and the UNCW community

10. Classrooms

- Used for course integrated library instruction and library workshops
- Active classroom (DH 2097) has moveable furniture and connective technology that allows for students to actively collaborate with the instructor and with each other


• Second floor connection to Randall Hall features extensive seating with ample natural light

12. Grand Reading Room

Deep quiet, silent study space with 12 semi-private study carrels that feature adjustable lighting

13. Lookout
